

**NAME**

CURLINFO\_COOKIELIST – get all known cookies

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_getinfo(CURL *handle, CURLINFO_COOKIELIST,  
                           struct curl_slist **cookies);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

Pass a pointer to a 'struct curl\_slist \*' to receive a linked-list of all cookies cURL knows (expired ones, too). Don't forget to call *curl\_slist\_free\_all(3)* on the list after it has been used. If there are no cookies (cookies for the handle have not been enabled or simply none have been received) 'struct curl\_slist \*' will be set to point to NULL.

Since 7.43.0 cookies that were imported in the Set-Cookie format without a domain name are not exported by this option.
